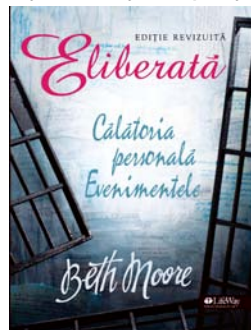
Diamonds...
