One testimony which recently came in just had to be shared with you. She has joyfully given permission to use her full name, because she wants everyone to know how marvelously the Lord has redeemed her situation for His glory. Here is her story:

I'm going to be very honest, and I will tell you what changes took place in my life as a consequence of this Bible study. My marriage had been a failure for a long time. We were both trying to conceal our conflicts and kept wearing this mask before those who knew us. We didn't want others to know what was going on between the two of us. We were guarreling and threatening each other frequently. My 11 yearold daughter was suffering very much, but we were so selfish that we could not think about her. He used to go away from home frequently. I used to fill my time navigating on the internet, and our child grew up alone. I knew God's Word. I got baptized in 1998 together with my husband, but after that I turned my back to God and thought that I could do everything on my own. I have come to know during these years that this was not true. When I finally realized that I was making a big mistake and at the same time I am condemning my daughter to death, I was filled with fear. I couldn't get settled. I had secretly started to make plans to run away from home, go to Italy and start a new life with another man, a so-called friend. My husband felt that something like that was going to happen, and one evening before we went to bed he told me, "You will regret this." I was speechless and kept wondering how did he know? Could it be this man who told him, but I did not dare ask. Next Sunday at church I found out about this Bible study. God bless you for this. My life has been changed radically. Ever since I started the Bible study I met new sisters in Christ, I made friends and most importantly, my marriage is shining now. Our home is an altar of God. We are faithful to our Lord Jesus, we go to church as a family, and most importantly, I have learned to trust God. I have also learned that "forgetting is the essence of forgiveness." Thank you for your patience with me. I hope my testimony is not too long and boring. I thank God that I am His child and that He is part of me. I send you kisses along with my love in Christ Jesus.
